

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Name of Mediator: Roger Gunn

Parties to the Dispute:

Kate Nosworthy (the Claimant)
Taekwondo Canada (the Respondent)

WHEREAS the Claimant wishes to have the following changes to the 2018 Youth Olympic Games Qualification Team;

AND WHEREAS the Claimant filed a Request to the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) on November 6, 2017;

AND WHEREAS all Parties wish to resolve any and all outstanding issues in respect of the Claimant's Request;

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

- A. Taekwondo Canada will run all 5 male and all 5 female divisions at the TC YOG Qualifier.
- B. At the conclusion of the qualifier, the following criteria will be used, for the gold medallists only from the TC YOG Qualifier, to determine the 3 males and 3 females selected to attend the WT YOG Qualifier:
 - a. Athletes will be given points based on the following structure to a maximum of 2 events total:
 - i. Events with a WT G-1 Ranking: Gold 10, Silver 6, Bronze 3.6;
 - ii. Events with a WT G-2 Ranking: Gold 20, Silver 12, Bronze 7.2.
 - b. The points may be earned in any weight class, and may not necessarily have been earned in the YOG weight in which they have won the TC YOG Qualifier.
 - c. Points must have been earned in events which occurred between January 1, 2017 and February 5, 2018. This would include the 2017 Pan Am Cadet and Junior Championships, which will carry points equivalent to a G2 ranking event noted above.
 - d. Athletes could earn up to a maximum of 30 points from a combination of two events only.
- C. If there is a tie, the athletes that are tied will then add in points from the 2018 Junior Nationals (in any weight class) based on the following: Gold 10, Silver 6, Bronze 3.6.
- D. If there is still a tie, the tie will go to the athlete with the highest earned points at a G2 event.
- E. If there is still a tie, the TC HP staff will appoint an impartial 3-member committee to review the results of the eligible athletes to assign the remaining spots.
- F. Taekwondo Canada agrees that this settlement is not precedent setting for any further policies going forward.
- G. Taekwondo Canada will make this agreement public.

H. The SDRCC shall declare this case closed by settlement agreement.


This settlement agreement may be signed in counterparts and transmitted by facsimile and when read together shall constitute one and the same agreement, effective as of Wednesday November 22, 2017
