Athlete Assistance Program (AAP)

Amendment of current Carding Criteria for 2021 Nominations

Date drafted: October 26th, 2020

Date approved: November 10th, 2020





1 Reasons for editing current (posted) document

- 1.1 The worldwide pandemic (COVID-19) affected all events since March 2020
- 1.2 Some events listed in the AAP 2021 carding nomination criteria (Tokyo Olympic Games & 2020 World Junior Championships) were cancelled.
- 1.3 Athletes currently carded for 2020 won't have the opportunity to secure their card for 2021
- 1.4 It's still unknown if any WT events will happen before July 2021...
- 1.5 One criteria (WT Olympic ranking: January 2021) from the AAP 2021 carding nomination criteria can still be used...

2 Proposed amendments

- 2.1 All athletes currently carded (2020 cycle) will be renominated for a further 12 month card at the same funding level (until December of 2021)
- 2.2 Any other athlete (not already carded in 2.1) meeting the current AAP 2021 carding nomination criteria (as published on our website) will be nominated for carding for the 2021 cycle
- 2.3 In the event a carded athlete (included in 2.1 & 2.2 above) would achieve a higher status for which he or she qualified for **PRIOR TO JULY 1ST 2021**, that athlete would then be carded at the higher level from the time he or she achieved that level.

3 Carded athletes for 2021:

- 3.1 **Skylar Park**: Second year of Senior International Card (**SR2**).
- 3.2 **Yvette Yong**: 12 month Senior Card (until December 2021)
- 3.3 **Ashley Kraayeveld**: 12 month Senior Card (until December 2021)
- 3.4 **Melissa Pagnotta**: 12 month Senior Card (until December 2021)
- 3.5 **Marc-André Bergeron**: 12 month Senior Card (until December 2021)
- 3.6 **Anthony Cappello**: 12 month Senior Card (until November 2021)

- 3.7 **Jordan Stewart**: Development Card for 2021 (Top 32 in WT Olympic Ranking)

Note that 3.7 is an extra card for which the athlete met the performance requirements based on published 2021 criteria, and is subject to additional funding being made available by Sport Canada
