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#### **DEFINTIONS**

- a) Conflicts of interest include both pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests.
- b) **Pecuniary interest** involves money and may include a direct or indirect financial gain, or the mitigation of financial loss, for the individual or another person with whom that individual is associated.
- c) Non-pecuniary interest involves relationships, and may include family relationships, friendships, volunteer positions in other associations or other interests that do not involve the potential for financial gain or loss.

#### **APPLICATION**

This document applies to all members of Taekwondo Canada's Board appointed and staff appointed committees.

#### STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS

Taekwondo Canada is incorporated under the *Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act* (the "*Act*") and is governed by the *Act* in matters involving a real or perceived conflict between the pecuniary or non-pecuniary interests of Directors, Officers and other individuals in decision-making or decision influencing roles, and the broader interests of the corporation.

#### ADDITIONAL OBLIGATIONS

In addition to fulfilling all requirements of the *Act*, Taekwondo Canada and its committee members will also fulfill the additional requirements of this policy. Committee members of Taekwondo Canada **will not**:

- Engage in any business or transaction, or have a financial or other personal interest that is incompatible
  with their official committee member duties with Taekwondo Canada;
- In the performance of their official committee member duties, accord preferential treatment to family members, friends and/or colleagues, or to organizations in which they, their family members, friends and/or colleagues have a role or an interest, financial or otherwise;
- Derive personal benefit from information that they acquire through their position as a committee member for Taekwondo Canada, where such information is confidential and/or not generally available to the public.
- Provide undue advantage to any other organization through information they acquire through their
  position as a committee member for Taekwondo Canada, where such information is confidential and/or \
  not generally available to the public.
- Use Taekwondo Canada property, equipment, supplies or services for activities not associated with the performance of official committee member duties with Taekwondo Canada;
- Place themselves in positions where they could, by virtue of being a committee member of Taekwondo Canada, influence decisions or contracts from which they could derive any direct or indirect benefit or interest;
- Accept any gift or favour that could be construed as being given in anticipation of, or in recognition for, any special consideration granted by virtue of being a committee member of Taekwondo Canada.



#### DISCLOSURES OF CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

- a. Upon appointment or reappointment to a committee, committee members will complete a written statement disclosing any real or perceived conflicts they may have, including identification of all other boards, committees and organizations in which they have a leadership or decision-making responsibility.
- b. At any time that a committee member of Taekwondo Canada becomes aware that there may exist a real or perceived conflict of interest, they shall disclose this conflict to the Board of Directors and the Executive Director immediately.
- c. Any person who is of the view that a committee member of Taekwondo Canada may be in a position of conflict of interest shall report this matter to the Board.

#### RESOLVING CONFLICTS OF INTEREST IN DECISION-MAKING

Decisions involving a real or perceived conflict of interest by a committee member of Taekwondo Canada may be made by Taekwondo Canada provided:

- The nature and extent of the committee member's interest has been fully disclosed to the body considering or making the decision and this disclosure is recorded in the minutes;
- The committee member does not participate in any discussion of the matter giving rise to the conflict of interest, unless the body considering the matter votes to allow such participation;
- The committee member abstains from voting on the proposed decision or transaction;
- The committee member is not counted to determine quorum for the proposed decision or transaction;

AND

The decision or transaction is in the best interests of Taekwondo Canada.

#### CONFIDENTIALITY

All members of Taekwondo Canada committees will abide by the Taekwondo Canada's Confidentiality policy.

#### **ENFORCEMENT**

Failure to comply with this policy, in letter and spirit, may result in discipline under Taekwondo Canada's Code of Conduct and Discipline Policy.
