# **PLATFORM**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

#### ATHLETES

- Must be registered and in good standing with their P/TSOs and Taekwondo Canada
- Black Belt athletes must have a Kukkiwon Certificate

#### PARA ATHLETES

In addition to the above athlete requirements Para Poomsae Athletes require INAS eligibility as seen on the INAS master list

# **COMPETITION FORMAT**

#### POOMSAE COMPETITION

- Competition will be held through pre-recorded videos
- All videos must abide by the video recording technical specifications published by World Taekwondo (See Video Requirements section)





- Poomsae videos will be uploaded using a single video to the athlete's personal or club YouTube channel
- Video YouTube links must be submitted on the registration form at the time of registration prior to the deadline
  - ▶ High Performance Athletes will submit a video link for each of their poomsae (two (2) separate video links)
- Recreational athletes: Select <u>one</u> compulsory poomsae of their choice from those listed in their division outlined in the Poomsae Competition Sections (<u>Recreational</u>)
- ▶ High-Performance athletes (Recognized): Poomsae Draws will be released on the Taekwondo Canada website on September 20, 2021 no later than 12:00 PM ET in accordance with World Taekwondo rules
- Para athletes: Select one poomsae of the athlete's choice (Para)

#### SCORING

- A minimum of three (3) judges will score both presentation and accuracy
  - The average of the scores will be the athlete's final score
- The maximum possible score based on presentation and accuracy is 10.0
- In the event of a tie, the athlete with the higher presentation score will determine the winner
  - If the score is still tied, then the two videos shall be scored by a panel of at least three (3) different judges

#### JUDGING

- Judging will occur over the Saturday and Sunday (competition dates), with results being determined by the highest average score
- Poomsae judging will not be live or streamed online

#### RESULTS

- Results will be determined using the highest average scores
- Results will be posted on the Taekwondo Canada website on the Tuesday, October 5, 2021





# **VIDEO REQUIREMENTS**

- All videos must abide by the video recording technical specifications published by World Taekwondo (See technical specifications here)
- ▶ Entirety of the Poomsae must be captured in one continuous recording
  - \* Beginning from *Charyeot* (attention) stance and ending at *Shi-o* (rest). Any video that is not one continuous recording and begins partway through the poomsae will not be scored and marked as disqualified \*
  - Video editing is prohibited
- Videos can be recorded indoors or outdoors
- Displays of political, religious and non-recognized NOC flags are prohibited
- All YouTube videos should be titled using the following format: First initial, Last Name, Birth year, Sex, Division, and Poomsae (ie. B.Rich, 1994, Female, Recreational 7-5 Gup, Taegeuk 4)
  - Pairs/Teams only need to list the first initial and last name of one individual, however ensure that Pairs or Teams is written in the title (ie. B.Rich, 1994, Female, HP Black Belt Pairs, Koryo)

- Major accuracy deductions (-0.3) will apply for the following at each instance:
  - Extra step taken to move around object or due to inadequate space
  - Missing kihap and/or stomp
  - Hand and/or foot movement out of the camera's view or due to poor lighting
- A one-time -0.6 deduction will apply for each of the following occurrences:
  - Camera moving during performance (no zooming in/out or panning left/right permitted)
  - Object, person, or pet coming into view during poomsae
  - Wearing footwear and/or hand coverings (ie. shoes, socks, gloves, etc.)
  - Restart
- Disqualification:
  - Athlete performs a poomsae other than the designated poomsae for his/her division
  - Video does not comply with the recording guidelines provided by World Taekwondo (see <u>Video Requirements</u>)

# EQUIPMENT

**Cadet Division (Ages 12-14):** White top with red and black collar, plus blue pants for males; the same top, but with red pants, for females.



**Junior and Senior Division (Ages 15-49):** White top with dark blue pants for males; white top with light blue pants for females.



Master Division (Ages 50 and up): Yellow top and dark blue pants for both males and females.







#### DEDUCTIONS

- ▶ 0.3 points deduction from accuracy:
  - Each extra step taken to move around object or due to inadequate space
  - ▶ Each hand and/or feet movement that cannot be seen by the referee as the participant moves beyond the camera's view
  - ▶ Each hand and/or feet movement that cannot be seen by the referee due to poor lighting (ie. Backlighting, lighting too bright/dim, etc.)
  - Each kihap and/or stomp that cannot be heard by the referee
- ▶ -0.3 points deduction from the final score will be given for the following
  - Overtime (at more than 90 seconds)
- → 0.6 points deduction from the final score will be given for the following:
  - Wearing incorrect dobok
  - Wearing incorrect belt
  - Wearing footwear and/or hand coverings (ie. shoes, socks, gloves, etc.)
  - Wearing jewelry
  - Object, person, or pet coming into view during poomsae
  - A restart
- Disqualification will be issued for the following:
  - Video does not comply with the recording guidelines provided by World Taekwondo (see <u>Video Requirements</u>)
  - Video has been edited or shows proof of editing
  - Display of political, religious and non-recognized NOC flags
  - Movement of camera during performance (up/down and zoom in/out)
  - ▶ Athlete performs a poomsae other than the designated poomsae for his/her division

- Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) individuals in each division
  - These medals will be mailed to each individual's taekwondo club

#### **MOST VALUABLE PLAYER (MVPS)**

- Grand Prize 13 Day Trip to Korea
  - \*Eligibility: Must be born in 1998, 1999, 2000, or 2001 and competing in the High-Performance Poomsae Competition as an individual
  - The Male and Female with the highest final score in the Individual High Performance Poomsae Competition (Recognized or Freestyle) that meet the prize eligibility requirements will receive an all-expense paid trip to Korea.
    - This trip will be 13 days in length from January 6-18, 2022 (dates and schedules are subject to changes) and will feature various cultural activities from Taekwondo and K-Pop to Olympic winter sports
    - More details regarding the Grand Prize trip to Korea will be provided closer to the event
- Prize Samsung Galaxy Tablet
  - \*Eligibility: Must be born in 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 or 2009 and competing in the High-Performance Poomsae Competition as an individual
  - The Male and Female born in 2004, 2005, or 2006 with the highest final score in the High Performance Poomsae Competition (Recognized or Freestyle) will receive a Prize Samsung Galaxy Tablet
  - The Male and Female born in 2007, 2008, 2009 with the highest final score in the High Performance Poomsae Competition (Recognized or Freestyle) will receive a Prize Samsung Galaxy Tablet



## PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT/WAIVER

Thank you for your interest in the 2021 Korean Ambassador's Cup. As a requirement for event registration, you must agree to the following terms and conditions:

I declare that I am over the age of 18 years old or I am a parent/guardian of a participant under the age of 18 years old.

- 1. I understand that as a condition of event participation, I must have insurance coverage in the event that I require emergency medical treatment. I may be asked to provide proof of my insurance information to the event organizers as a condition of participation.
- I am fully aware of the risks involved and the degree of fitness required in taking part in this
  event. I accept that the event organizers and their agents cannot be held responsible for any
  injury or loss, however caused.
- 3. I have not suffered a concussion for which I have not been medically cleared to compete, or suffered a concussion for which I have not been treated in the last 30 days.
- 4. I understand that I am expected to have completed Making Head Way in Sport and have familiarized myself with concussion return to play steps.
- 5. Lagree to allow Taekwondo Canada and their agents to capture myself on still image or video for the purposes of promotion.
- 6. Lunderstand that all fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 7. I understand that all athletes and their clubs are required to register with Taekwondo Canada prior to registration.
- 8. I have reviewed and understand the anti-doping policies of Taekwondo Canada, WADA and CCES.
- 9. Athletes and coaches must adhere to the policies of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA). I understand that as a participant, I, or my athlete, may be subject to anti-doping testing.
- 10. I have reviewed the list of prohibited substances recognized by WADA found on the Prohibited List.
- 11. I understand that an athlete is required to declare a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) for medication used for illness or other medical reasons if the medication is on <u>WADA's 2021</u> <u>Prohibited List</u>. More information on TUE can be found <u>here</u>.
