Video Submission Requirements

- Video submission deadline is Wednesday, March 2nd by 11:59pm ET.

- Uniforms for the event must be the new official uniform with the WT logo, country code on the back, and flag on the sleeve.
- Event dates are Thursday, March 3rd and Friday, March 4th.

Documentation Requirements

- ► The deadline for submission of all completed documentation to TC is March 7th by 9:00pm Eastern.
 - Missing this deadline or not providing completed documents will make those participants ineligible to attend the event.

Costs and Accommodations

- Unless otherwise stipulated, all costs to participate in the event are the responsibility of the participant.
 - Must bring USD \$100/event in cash for registration fee at time of accreditation.
- Accommodation expenses will need to be reconciled with TC after registration in the event. More details will be forthcoming.
- Our priority will be the closer locations.

Visa Requirements

- All participants will require a visa to enter Korea.
- You will need a letter of invitation from the organizing committee in order to apply for one, which we will not receive until the National Team is entered into the event.
- Visa applications must be done by individuals, we are unable to do this as a group.
- We have been advised that it will take up to 2 weeks for applications to be processed.

COVID-19 Quarantine Exemption Application

- Currently, there is a mandatory 7-day quarantine period for individuals entering Korea.
- If approved, the Quarantine Waiver Application is good for 7 days and can be extended to a maximum of 14 days. An extension will require an additional PCR test at a Government recognized testing site.
- Information from the embassy in Canada indicates that Quarantine Exemption Certificates are used 1-week prior to the anticipated travel date.

COVID-19 Testing Requirements for Travel

- Regardless of vaccination status, all participants entering Korea must show proof of a negative PCR test issued within 48 hours of their departure flight.
 - Test method must be PCR based on DNA amplification (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, SDA, NEAR, etc.).
 - Antigen, antibody, and all forms of self-administered tests are not valid.
- ► The test report must contain the following information:
 - Name (needs to match the name on the passport); Date of Birth; Test Method; Test Date; Test Result; Date of Issuance; Name of Testing Centre
- The test result must be NEGATIVE



COVID-19 Testing Requirements for Travel

- INDETERMINATE or UNCLEAR are both invalid.
- The test report must be written in Korean or English.
- As per the latest guidelines, PCR test results issued by any testing centre in Canada is valid (subject to change).

- COVID-19 testing requirements for the return to Canada will be based on Health Canada guidelines at the time of return.



COVID-19 Event Protocols

- Upon arrival, a COVID-19 PCR test will be performed on each participant. This test will occur at a temporary residential facility and all participants must wait at the facility until a negative result is returned. Participants may be required to wait at the facility from anywhere between a few hours to a full day.
- If a negative test is returned and the participants have a Quarantine Exemption Certificate, they will be required to download and install the self-diagnosis app and will be permitted to leave the facility for the host hotel.
 - All participants will have a daily rapid antigen detection test during the competition.



- Additional PCR testing is required if the participant is in Korea for more than 7 days under a Quarantine Exemption.
- All participants must wear a mask in public places, and will have their body temperature checked when entering or exiting the hotel or competition venue.
- Participants are not allowed to exit or leave the event premises (hotel or competition venue) until they complete their competition and they depart Korea. There are no exceptions.
- In the event of a medical emergency, the COVID-19 coordinator and physician in charge at the event will permit and/or escort the athlete or coach/staff member to an exit for transportation to a medical facility.



Outfitting and Team Support

- Official team kit and uniforms will be provided based on information submitted through the Participant Information form.
 - All items will be shipped to the home address provided on the Participant Information form.

 - Medical support for acute issues and on-site injury management.
- Head Coach May be appointed.



Important Considerations

- Potential COVID-19 Specific Complications
 - Participants that are minors must travel with a Responsible Adult. You will need to have a quarantine plan in the event there is a positive COVID-19 test.
 - Unsure what process will be for non-National Team members.
 - Hotel costs during quarantine in addition to quarantine facility costs.
 - In order to meet the WT timelines, flights need to be booked before it will be known if the event receives a Quarantine Waiver.
 - What is your plan if you do not receive a Quarantine Exemption Certification?
 - What if only a part of your group does not receive an exemption?
