

March 29th Update Notice Regarding Goyang 2022 World Taekwondo Poomsae Championships

As we continue to plan towards attending the Goyang 2022 World Taekwondo Poomsae Championships, we would like to provide all participants with the most recent information that we have. Below is a summary of event information that was received on March 28th, 2022 from the local Organizing Committee (OC).

- Necessary documents and important information for entrance into Korea.
 - Negative PCR test certificate (refer to the attached reference document).
 - Q-CODE (refer to the attached reference document).
 - When entering the country, please submit the document (PCR test result, complete recovery report, etc.) separately to the quarantine officer (Korean or English).
- Transportation is only provided to those who arrive between April 16th to April 25th.
- When entering the country, only asymptomatic individuals will be exempt from quarantine.
 - If classified as symptomatic, sample collection will be conducted at the Korean government quarantine station and quarantine facilities.
- When entering the country from April 16th or afterwards, the OC will make group reservations for PCR tests (for those who reserve accommodation exclusively for competitions.)
 - The OC made a reservation at T1 (East), T1 (West), and T2 Center.
 - Shuttle service from the airport to the accommodation to be provided by OC.
 - Please wait at the accommodation until your PCR results are confirmed.

If you enter the country before April 16th, after making a personal reservation (<https://safe2gopass.com/index>), report the PCR test results to the OC.

- April 18th is the earliest day for the registration for athletes.
 - Teams can move to registration center by shuttle service only if CLO (COVID-19 Liaison Officer is our Team Manager, Lisa-Mae) submits PCR test results to the OC.

6. Available hours at training facility.
 - Only teams whose CLO submits the self-diagnosis results to the OC can use the training space.
 - Training hours for each country will be announced later and the training space can be used at the designated time for the country from April 18th to April 20th.
 - The training facility is not open during the competition period from April 21 to April 24.
7. CLO must submit the self-diagnosis results each day to the OC by 10:00 p.m., and these results clear participants for the following day.
 - Entrance to the venue will be limited to those with negative results from the CLO.
 - Organization Committee provides self-diagnosis kits.
8. Shuttle service to the airport inspection and COVID testing center is provided until April 25th.
 - Any required pre-departure testing (for return flights after the event) is at the participants own expense.
 - Posted costs of testing at the airport centre:
 - PCR Test -> Weekdays KRW 124,000 and Weekends KRW 130,000
 - Antigen Test -> Weekdays KRW 74,000 and Weekends KRW 80,000
9. NOTICE for those Entering and Departing the country in the non-official time period (the official time period is from April 16th to April 25th)
 - The arrival PCR test is conducted at Incheon International Airport at your own cost. See Point #4 above.
 - Stay according to the personal entry procedure, submit the PCR test results to OC immediately.
 - Move to the official accommodation facility after **April 16th**
 - Transportation support is not provided.
10. In case you are tested positive for COVID-19, during the official competition period.
 - Follow the OC's instruction until your departure.
 - Temporary housing for the quarantine is provided by the OC and the Korean government. Anyone who is tested COVID-19 positive is quarantined for about 7 days and can leave the country after being released from quarantine.
 - In the event of being placed in quarantine, entry fees and accommodation costs will not be refunded.
 - If the Korean government allocates quarantine space, the participant may be responsible for associated quarantine hospitalization treatment costs.
 - When entering Korea before April 16th or leaving after April 25th, the OC does not provide an isolation space and the participant will be responsible for all associated costs related to quarantine in a government facility.
