#### **General Planning Considerations**

- ► There will be a team training session April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 6:00pm to 8:00pm Eastern. More information to follow.
- As far as we know, transport to the host hotels will be provided if arriving on or after April 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Entry and Accreditation**

#### **Medical Control WADA Rules Apply**

- Ensure you have travel medical insurance.
- If you are unfamiliar with anti-doping procedures, I would strongly suggest that you have a look at the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) resources: <a href="https://cces.ca/course-outline">https://cces.ca/course-outline</a>.
- Check any medications that you currently take through the website Global DRO: <a href="https://www.globaldro.com/Home">https://www.globaldro.com/Home</a>.
- If you are taking a medication that is prohibited in competition, then you can apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). The process to apply for a TUE can be found on WT's website at:

#### **Team Training and Attire**

- We will be using a Whatsapp group chat for communication.
- Team training will be arranged upon arrival by the team coaches.
- Please wear Canada clothing at all team meetings and when going to the competition venue. Pack extra Canada shirts if you have them.
- Label any personal items (re: rollers, bands, etc...).
- Bring a reusable water bottle, only reusable items are allowed in the venue.
- Team photos will be taken on-site.

#### **Freestyle Music Requirements**

- All music must be submitted on a USB stick at the Head of Team meeting.
  - Each filename must have Country, Category, and Athlete Names
- USB Should be marked with the name of the country.
- Submit in a bag or envelope with a slip of paper that lists:
  - Country, Category, and Athlete Names for each file on the drive.



#### **Important Travel Tips**

- The won is the official currency of South Korea. It is best to convert some cash before you leave. Make sure you bring some US dollars for registration, plus it's typically easy to convert USD to won.
- Local SIM cards are likely an option or look at having a travel plan added to your cellphone.
- For your carry-on:
  - Pack your team jacket, belt, and uniform.
  - All medications.
  - Basic toiletries.
  - At least 1 change of clothes, but preferably 2.
  - Travel laundry detergent.
  - Follow airline rules for liquids and sharp objects.
  - Follow airline rules for baggage.





## **Review of COVID Specific Information**



#### **COVID-19 Quarantine Exemption**

- As of March 21<sup>st</sup>, the Korean Government will remove the mandatory isolation period for fully-vaccinated travellers.
- Completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> dose between 14 and 180 days of arrival.
- Completion of 3<sup>rd</sup> dose.
- Completion of 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson
- Cross-vaccination is also recognized.
- Must register with Quarantine Information Pre-Entry System (Q-CODE).

### **COVID-19 Testing Requirements for Travel**

- Regardless of vaccination status, all participants entering Korea must show proof of a negative PCR test issued within 48 hours of their departure flight.
  - Test method must be PCR based on DNA amplification (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, SDA, NEAR, etc.).
  - Antigen, antibody, and all forms of self-administered tests are not valid.
- ► The test report must contain the following information:
  - Name (needs to match the name on the passport); Date of Birth; Test Method; Test Date; Test Result; Date of Issuance; Name of Testing Centre
- The test result must be NEGATIVE



#### **COVID-19 Testing Requirements for Travel**

- INDETERMINATE or UNCLEAR are both invalid.
- The test report must be written in Korean or English.
- As per the latest guidelines, PCR test results issued by any testing centre in Canada is valid (subject to change).

- COVID-19 testing requirements for the return to Canada will be based on Health Canada guidelines at the time of return.



#### **COVID-19 Event Protocols**

- Upon arrival, a COVID-19 PCR test will be performed on each participant. This test will occur at a temporary residential facility and all participants must wait at the facility until a negative result is returned. Participants may be required to wait at the facility from anywhere between a few hours to a full day.
- If a negative test is returned, they will be required to download and install the self-diagnosis app and will be permitted to leave the facility for the host hotel.
  - All participants will have a daily rapid antigen detection test during the competition.



- All participants must wear a mask in public places, and will have their body temperature checked when entering or exiting the hotel or competition venue.
- Participants are not allowed to exit or leave the event premises (hotel or competition venue) until they complete their competition and they depart Korea. There are no exceptions.
- In the event of a medical emergency, the COVID-19 coordinator and physician in charge at the event will permit and/or escort the athlete or coach/staff member to an exit for transportation to a medical facility.
