EXPLANATORY NOTES BY EVENT

An NOC qualifies for the MIXED TEAM KYORUGI event if it has 3 or more athletes qualified in any of the events and fulfilling the maximum quota established per NOC.

NOCs that have more than 3 athletes must select the 3 athletes that meet the weight requirement per team, thus forming the mixed team. If any of the athletes had an injury before starting the individual competition, the NOC would have the possibility to use a substitute from the qualified athletes, as long as they meet the weight requirement.

Athletes must have the team weight on the third day of competition:

Mixed Team: -200 kg

Qualification for the Poomsae Event will be for 2 athletes, who will compete in 2 modalities:

- Poomsae Freestyle Mixed Pairs
- Individual Traditional Poomsae (Women and Men)

The same 2 athletes who compete in Pairs Freestyle will be the same athletes who will compete in the Individual Traditional event.

Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

All participating athletes must be in the U22 category; that is, athletes born between 2004 – 2009.

All athletes must participate in at least **3 of the 4 qualification events** to be placed in the PATU U22 single ranking and this way, be able to obtain qualification for the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

The ranking is obtained by the participation of the same athlete in the different qualification events, that is, the athlete cannot be changed from one event to another.

All athletes must have qualified by the PATU U22 single ranking.

In order to obtain their quotas, athletes from the host country must participate in at least **1 of the 4 qualification events** of the PATU U22 single ranking; thus, in the competition they will be awarded the #4 spot of the ranking.



Team members

- **Athletes:**
 - **Kyorugi:**
 - Men: One per Kyorugi weight division (Maximum 4 men per team)
 - Women: One per Kyorugi weight division (Maximum 4 women per team)

 - **Poomsae:**
 - Men: Maximum 1
 - Women: Maximum 1
 - Athletes of the individual Poomsae category who participate in the traditional style event must be included in the freestyle pairs event (1 man, 1 woman).
- **Coaches:**
 - **Kyorugi:**
 - Men: Maximum 2 for the men's team
 - Women: Maximum 2 for the women's team

 - **Poomsae:**
 - Maximum 2 per pair, the coaches will be the same for the Individual Traditional Poomsae event.

Due to an extraordinary situation, the event scheduled for February in Costa Rica has been cancelled, therefore, the qualification will be through a Ranking Process called PATU Under 22 Single Ranking, whose score will be obtained from the final sum **of the 4 Qualifying events**. The table with the details will be available on the PATU official website.

Wild Card

Wild cards for the Kyorugi and Poomsae events will be considered and granted **ONLY** to MNA participants that have not qualified any athlete. MNAs of PATU that do not participate in at least one of the qualification event cannot be eligible to receive wild cards.



Confirmation of quotas

The PATU will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified by **April 9, 2025**.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to the PATU the places they will use no later than **April 16, 2025**.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, the PATU will reallocate unused quotas to the next best positioned NOC that has not yet qualified, no later than **April 23, 2025**.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than **April 30, 2025**.

Qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games

In Taekwondo, all gold medalists of individual events will obtain direct qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, 4 spots in Kyorugi and 1 spot in Poomsae per gender (10 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

The places obtained are for the athletes, not for the country. If the athlete who earned the quota cannot participate in the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete placed in another position in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025.
